Dear Parents,

By now you would have heard of the murder of a Prisons Officer in his car outside the college earlier this afternoon. It is an unfortunate reminder of the dangers that exist around us and the need to be more vigilant in matters related to safety at school and the environs.

This evening I have spoken to members of our Crisis Management Committee requesting them to accelerate the formation and execution of a 'lock down procedure' at the college. This begins next week and will be completed as soon as is possible.

In a recent e-mail sent to you, I urged that you speak to your sons about venturing out after arriving to school on mornings, and also the unhealthy practice of walking on the street with earphones in their ears. I again urge you to address this with them. The school will also be taking steps to prevent students from leaving the compound before start time, once they have arrived. Students will also not be permitted to leave the compound during the lunch period, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. Sometimes parents may send a note requesting such be done, but I strongly urge that this be discouraged for safer alternatives. Students are not to wait outside of the college for pick-up after school. They are to wait on the school compound. If they are travelling home please urge them to proceed on their way and not loiter.

We continue to do our best to ensure your sons safety in these times and appreciate your support to this end.

Let us continue to pray for our country and do our part to make things better.
